A Precious Child: A Beacon of Hope

The Denver Advisory Committee of the Aegon Transamerica Foundation remains steadfast in its support for A Precious Child, an organization dedicated to providing opportunities and resources for children in need. Serving more than 50,000 children annually, A Precious Child stands as a beacon of hope for families facing adversity, including abuse, neglect, crisis situations, and poverty.

Recently, A Precious Child demonstrated its unwavering community commitment by aiding victims of the devastating Marshall Fire, distributing clothing and necessities to those affected resulting in nearly \$4 million in resources distributed to the Marshall Fire community. Through its core initiatives, A Precious Child focuses on holistic child development, offering basic essentials and resource navigation through its Empowerment Resource Center and Satellite Resource Centers. A Precious Child offers additional resources through programs focusing on social and emotional well-being, academic success and workforce development.

For over six years, the Denver Advisory Committee has proudly supported A Precious Child. Parallel to the Foundation's financial support, a favorite event of Transamerica employees in Denver is "Fill A Backpack," where last year Transamerica employees generously contributed school supplies and backpacks for 114 underprivileged children. These efforts help ensure that every child can reach their full potential, regardless of their circumstances.
